What an incredible Spring term Nursery class have had! It has been filled with enthusiasm and a great deal of hard work which is a great reminder of how proud we are of each and every child here. The children have really enjoyed their topic this half term. They have had lots of fun learning about 'space' blasting the rockets, painting space and earth pictures, imagining to be on the moon and writing letters to their parents on earth. In the next half term, we will start with the topic '**Growth.**' We will have a large focus on growth, change and decay. We will explore how plants, animals and people grow and how we can support all of these types of growth. We will be continuing to develop our understanding of numbers, counting in order and using 1-to-1 correspondence as we count seeds, bulbs, petals, stems and leaves. We will also develop our understanding of measurements as we measure our height, weight, size and the different sizes of flowers, animals and plants.
